 - i. Horizon Environmental Stephanie Woods gave a presentation on the operations and capabilities for Horizon Environmental. Can clean hazard waste and no hazardous waste. Cleaning of tanks. Cleaning of waterways. Remediation work and soil testing. The Emergency response department has a 24 hours a day hotline. Horizon Environmental has a local shop on Highway 77. Locals cannot call Horizon on behalf of TXDot roadway that has to come from TXDot. They are also into hydro excavation.
 - ii. Lone Star HazMat Tyler Lenius gave a presentation on operations of Lone Star Hazmat. The company started in Lufkins Texas over 20 years ago. Now there are 15 offices across the state of Texas, Oklahoma, and Louisiana. Emergency response capabilities hazardous and non-hazardous spill response, roadside incidents and facility releases. They also help with spill and leak containment, load shift and product transfers, decon operations. Now Lonestar HazMat offers waste management services along with remediation and environmental services. Other services offered transportation and support fleet along
