2. Belinda Gonzalez gave an update on Parents as Teacher (PAT). The PAT caseload is at 45 of 60 families with 1 spots being held for Spanish speaking families. Next group connection will take place 4-11-19 at the health department with Mid-Coast Family Services presenting on tobacco cessation.	No Action
3. Leslie Kallus gave an update on Family Connects (FC). Birth rates for February were low with 50 total births, with 22 Victoria County and 12 accepting home visits. Working on getting more community buy in and recommendations for the committee on how to do that.	No Action

5. Nidra King gave an update on the Committee's Dr. Seuss Family Literacy Event on 3-22-19. There were 114 participants, 45 adults and 69 children. 12 door prizes were donated by attending vendors. There were 21 vendor booths. A \$100 donation from HEB purchased 100 books, \$100 donation from Victoria Area Nurse Practitioners purchased 100 books, \$50 donation from an anonymous donor purchased 50 books, a donation from the Children's Discovery	No Action

Museum of 25 books to total 275 books. The Committee purchased 100 books. The Green eggs and ham cooking demo and the reading station was a big hit with families. Advertising for event was a success, 1500 flyers were distributed at Chick-fil-a, 50 flyers distributed through WIC, flyers were placed at daycares, laundry mats, public library and head start.
